Upcoming local surgeries:

Crime:

I have reviewed crime recorded by Kent Police for Teynham and Lynsted during the month of February 2024. The following incidents of note occurred:

<u>05/02/2024</u> – **Conyer** – Report of group of youths kicking the victim's door; this has damaged the lock. Image of suspect has been circulated internally and awaiting positive identification.

<u>07/02/2024</u> - **Teynham** - Report of a theft of a mini digger from Faversham, which was tracked to a location in Teynham. The victim attended and was met by three unknown males who threatened the victim. This made the victim fear for their safety, and they left the scene. Extensive enquiries were made to try and identify the males, the vehicle and where the digger had been taken but unfortunately were negative. I will be continuing to monitor the area for suspicious activity and if any residents do see anything of concern, please do contact Kent Police.

<u>09/02/2024</u> – **Teynham** - Report of a dog bite where a resident had been out jogging and a dog came out and bit him on the back of his leg. Unfortunately, we have been unable to establish who dog owner is, but I would like to reassure residents that the victim suffered no lasting injuries. I will continue to monitor for reports of dangerous dogs and seek the support of the local dog warden and dog liaison officers within the police should the need arise.

12/02/2024 – **Teynham** – Report of damage to meter-box, following a group of young people 'hanging around' in the area. Report filed as no lines of enquiry.

<u>18/02/2024</u> – **Teynham** – Report of threats to cause harm being made to the victim, following an incident in the play park. This investigation is still under review as CCTV has been obtained. If you have any information relating to this incident and who was involved, please contact Kent Police.

26/02/2024 – **Teynham** - Report of a damaged window which appeared to have been caused by a ball bearing. Report filed as no lines of enquiry.

Anti-Social Behaviour:


I have reviewed all calls into Kent Police for Teynham and Lynsted during the month of February 2024. The following incidents of ASB occurred:


